High Speed Hard Floor Care



1 Dust mop 1 or more times per day to remove surface soil.



7 Pick up trail with a clean mop and water.



13 Always make sure there is a sufficient finish base on the floor before buffing with a high-speed machine to avoid permanent tile damage.



2 Use scraper and gum remover to remove gum and other attached soil deposits.



8 If automatic is not available, liberally apply all purpose solution with mop.



14 Once floor is dry, walk in a straight line at normal pace with a high-speed machine.



3 Vacuum or shake out walk-off mats. Replace mats as needed. The more dirt you stop at the entrances, the longer the floor finish will last and maintain a higher appearance level.



9 Scrub with circular scrubber, equipped with a red pad.



15 Do not stop or allow machine to run in one spot.



4 Mix all purpose cleaner following label directions.



10 Pick up solution with wet/dry vacuum or mop. Rinse using clean mop, changing water frequently.



16 When finished, dust mop entire area.



5 Fill automatic scrubber with all purpose solution.



11 Make sure floor is clean. If not, repeat above procedure.



17 Clean and store all equipment for future use.



6 Scrub area with an automatic equipped with red pads, using medium pad pressure, with feed valve 3/4 open, squeegee down, and vacuum motor on.



12 Allow floor to dry.
