

# Restroom Care

Using Checklist, assemble all necessary equipment and chemicals on maid's cart.



Remove graffiti from walls with graffiti remover.



Using creme cleanser, scrub basins with a scrubbing pad. Rinse and polish dry with a clean towel.



Flush toilets and urinals. remove urinal screens and blocks.



Spray washroom cleaner on shelves, paper towel dispensers, trash cans, partitions, and behind basins. Wipe sprayed surfaces with sponge.



Use stainless steel cleaner to polish all metal fixtures.



Fill trigger sprayer with cleaner/disinfectant. Spray solution into each fixture. Spray on/wipe off on walls, partitions and around urinals.



Using bowl mop, clean interior of toilets and urinals and flush.



Spray all mirrors with glass cleaner and wipe with a clean cloth.



Empty all waste receptacles and replace plastic bags where necessary.



Spray washroom cleaner on toilet exteriors and urinals and wipe with a sponge.



Mix germicidal cleaner according to label directions in warm/hot water.



Refill all towel, sanitary napkin, tissue, and soap dispensers.



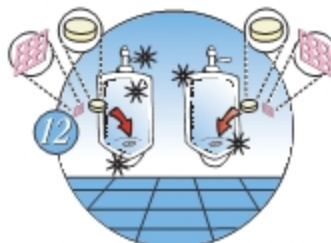
Using germicidal cleaner, spray tops and bottoms of toilet seats. Wipe sprayed areas with sponge.



Mop the floor from the far end working toward the door and rinse.



Sweep and pick up paper and trash from floor with broom and dustpan. Use long-handled scraper and gum remover to remove gum and other attached soil deposits.



Replace urinal screens and blocks.



Clean all equipment and store neatly for next day's use.
